



CENSORSHIP AMERIKAN STYLE

IN 1971, PRISONERS IN ATTICA STAGED AN UPRISING TO DEMAND HUMANE TREATMENT. OVER THIRTY YEARS LATER, NOTHING HAS CHANGED.

IN ATTICA PRISON, constitutional rights are squashed as a matter of policy, and censorship is used as a tool to crush political tendencies in prisoners. Everything from newspapers to books, even handwritten letters, are either censored or denied altogether. Most Amerikans believe the myth that such methods of oppression exist only in "backwards" nations, and basic humyn rights are taken for granted. Reality, however, paints a much darker picture of the conditions millions of warehoused people deal with every day.

WHAT YOU CAN DO: Write, call, email, or fax the superintendent of Attica or your local congressional representative, demanding the institution of basic constitutional rights for prisoners at Attica.
